



Free Dental Screenings at your Primary School

Dear Parents/Guardian,

Banyule Community Health Service is sending qualified dental staff to your school to conduct FREE dental screenings on children's teeth as part of the School of Smiles program. If you wish for your child to have an oral health screening, please complete the attached Consent and Medical History Form. Participation in the program is voluntary and you may withdraw your child at any time. If you choose not to participate, this will have no effect on you or your child's dental care at Banyule Community Health. All information collected before and during the screening will remain confidential.

After the screening we will inform you via letter if your child has any signs of decay or cavities. If needed, please make a follow-up appointment at Banyule Community Health or your private dentist. All children 12 years old and under are eligible for free dental treatment at Banyule Community Health's Public Dental Clinic, therefore incurring no cost for follow up treatment.

All children will be educated on how to maintain healthy teeth and will receive a take-home information pack to promote healthy oral hygiene.

- 48% of 3 year olds & 63% of 9 year olds have decayed, missing or filled baby teeth.
- Dental decay is one of the most common chronic conditions in early childhood
- Dental decay is largely preventable

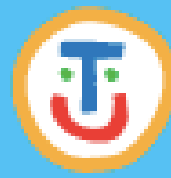

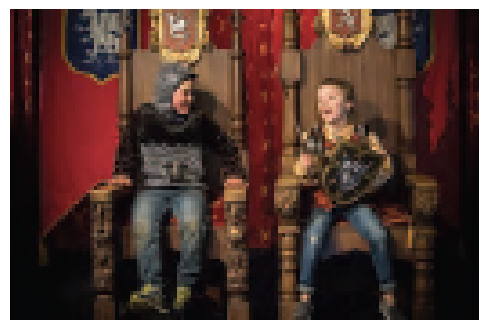

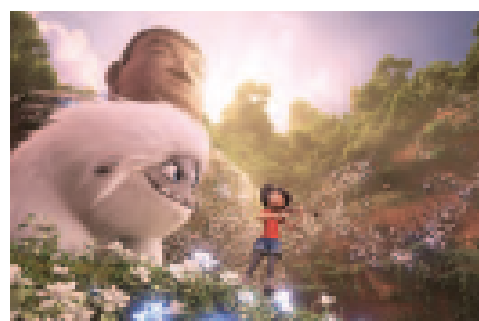
Musical Melodies - Wednesday 2 October

Rockin' Rome - Friday 4 October

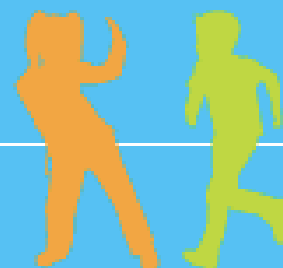

What to Bring

✓ Food

- A healthy morning tea and lunch such as fruits, wholemeal sandwiches and dips. For lunchbox ideas visit <http://heas.health.vic.gov.au/schools/healthy-lunchboxes>. Please do not include items which need to be reheated.
- Due to the risk of anaphylaxis items containing nuts should not be included in the lunchbox.
- Breakfast and afternoon tea will be provided.

✓ A drink bottle

- Water will be available all day to refill the bottles.

✓ Hat

- A SunSmart hat similar to the one worn at school.
- Sunscreen will be provided throughout the day.

✓ Appropriate clothing

- Clothing suitable for an active day, including closed toe shoes and a jacket if it is predicted to be wet or cold.

✓ Medication

- Medication and Management/Action Plans if required.

✗ Devices

- We encourage children to be active and engage with their peers so personal electronic devices such as phones, iPads, laptops and game consoles should be left at home.
- These devices will remain the families responsibly through the session, including for any loss or damage.

Medical Management plans

If your child has been diagnosed with a medical condition, we are required under the Education & Care regulations to have a completed medical action/management plan, along with any medication which may be required available at the service at all times during your child's attendance.

Blank copies of the medical plans can be accessed through your medical practitioner or from the TheirCare service.

In the interests of the child's safety, care may be refused on the day should the appropriate documentation or medication not be supplied or is incomplete.

Changes to programming

Activities and times are subject change due to unforeseen circumstances such as severe weather and provider availability. In the rare event that an activity will unable to be run, an alternative activity will be provided and will be communicate the change via email/SMS to all families who are effected and will be updated on the website.

Changes to your booking

We understand that your needs may change in the lead up to your attendance at the Holiday Program. Whether you need to add an additional day to keep the kids busy or cancel a day to suit your schedule, we're there for you.

Simply log into your Fully Booked account anytime to make the relevant changes or give us a call on 1300 072 410 between 8:30 am to 6:00 pm on weekdays.

As we plan our programming, suppliers and educators in advance to the day to ensure that the children have lots of fun. Any changes made within the 5 days of booking will incur a \$10.00 charge.

When making additional bookings, the \$10.00 is eligible for the Child Care Subsidy, which means you may only need to pay the gap, depending on your families' circumstances.
